paul j ioannidis first met aristotle onassis in cairo in 1956 the decorated resistance fighter quickly became one of onassis most trusted business associates eventually becoming the director general of onassis owned olympic airways and one of the founding board members of the alexander s onassis foundation for 57 years he worked with the onassis group and he has spent nearly 43 years as a close advisor and friend of the onassis family sharing a special relationship with onassis children alexander and christina for the first time in english ioannidis tells his story tracing back to his days as a rebel fighter against the nazis he also tells the story of how onassis founded olympic airways becoming one of only two men in the world at the time to own his own airline the other was howard hughes the owner of twa like an ancient greek tragedy onassis story unfolds from losing his son and successor in a horrific plane accident to losing his own health before his daughter was ready to assume leadership of the business empire that he had built ioannidis is there when onassis enters his dying son s room he s at the controls of a private flight to crete with opera singer maria callas and he witnesses the strain between onassis wife jacqueline kennedy onassis and his daughter christina over the terms of aristotle s will after christina s untimely death he is one of four men who managed the estate of her minor daughter athina an estate that prompted an intense legal struggle with her father thierry rousset with intimate details and documentation this eyewitness reveals information about the saga of the onassis family that has never before been published and
