aqm should give highest priority to reducing pollutants linked to high morbidity and mortality pm_{2.5} and precursors like sox and nox from mobile sources a second level short term priority could be pm_{2.5} sox and emissions of toxic metals from stationary sources an important medium term priority should be mass transportation in major cities controlling traffic and restricting private cars during high pollution episodes a long term priority could be taxing hydrocarbons based on their contribution to greenhouse gases
