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the routledge handbook of the history of settler colonialism examines the global history of settler colonialism as a distinct mode of domination from ancient times to the present day it explores the ways in which new polities were established in freshly discovered new worlds

and covers the history of many countries including australia new zealand israel japan south africa liberia algeria canada and the usa chronologically as well as geographically wide reaching this volume focuses on an extensive array of topics and regions ranging from settler colonialism in the neo assyrian and roman empires to relationships between indigenes and newcomers in new spain and the early mexican republic to the settler dominated polities of africa during the twentieth century its twenty nine inter disciplinary chapters focus on single colonies or on regional developments that straddle the borders of present day states on successful settlements that would go on to become powerful settler nations on failed settler colonies and on the historiographies of these experiences taking a fundamentally international approach to the topic this book analyses the varied experiences of settler colonialism in countries around the world with a synthesizing yet original introduction this is a landmark contribution to the emerging field of settler colonial studies and will be a valuable resource for anyone interested in the global history of imperialism and colonialism
